

2024 ASEAN-Korea Academic Essay Contest

As of March 14, 2024

I. BACKGROUND

ASEAN-Korea relations continue to center around their community of people in strengthening its partnership. The idea of further enhancing people-to-people cooperation between two regions was also addressed at the 24th ASEAN-ROK Summit last September¹. The Korea-ASEAN Solidarity Initiative (KASI) under the Republic of Korea's (ROK) Indo-Pacific Strategy was announced, highlighting the importance of the further promotion of youth's greater participation and engagement (#7 of Core Lines of Effort). The effort is also aligned with one of the core objectives, focusing on forging people-to-people exchanges, outlined in the ASEAN Outlook on the Indo-Pacific (AOIP). Based on the common vision built upon the KASI and AOIP, it could be reinforced for more effective outcomes. In this connection, efforts towards solidifying the partnership within the youth population will persist as the ASEAN-Korea Centre's (AKC) priority program activities, such as the 'ASEAN-Korea Academic Essay Contest'* (Essay Contest hereafter). Students will be asked to elaborate their essays within the focus areas between ASEAN and Korea, such as maritime cooperation and sustainable development.

* Since 2016, the AKC has annually organized the 'ASEAN-Korea Academic Essay Contest' aimed at raising youth's voices on ASEAN-Korea relations related critical issues as well as enhancing youth's interest and engagement on issues that are important to the current and future partnership between ASEAN and Korea.

In other words, as the future of ASEAN-Korea community and potential beneficiaries of a sustainable and healthy ASEAN-Korea partnership, it is important for youth to maintain interests in emerging and nascent topics for ASEAN-Korea relations. This as a whole can help youth to build their own perspectives on how to be a pathway forward to shape and navigate the future relationship between ASEAN and Korea.

Recognizing such significance, AKC is committed to ensure higher quality essays and keep the essay contest's format in a fair and coordinated framework. Specifically, it regularly conducts the evaluation process in the following stages: (1) the initial proposal evaluation stage by academic partners, and (2) evaluation of essays by AKC and academic partners.

This year, winners² of the Essay Contest will be awarded study visits to ROK and one ASEAN Member State (two grand prizes), four cash prizes and award certificates. Moreover, two grand prize winners will be invited to present their winning essays at the sideline of an academic conference in Korea. Through their participation in the conference, it is also an opportune time for the winners to present their essays, participate in discussions, and more importantly build academic networks with academia and fellow young scholar counterparts by sharing their essay ideas towards elevating the ASEAN and Korea partnership. Winning papers will also be promoted through AKC's media platforms including its website and e-newsletter.

- 2. Foster deeper understanding of ASEAN-Korea relations by encouraging students to undertake research and produce scholarly works on ASEAN-Korea partnership

- 1. Gain insights on youth's perspectives for a sustainable and mutually beneficial ASEAN-Korea partnership
- 2. Enhance mutual understanding among the youth on ASEAN-Korea relations through research and knowledge exchange
- 3. Nurture next-generation scholars of ASEAN and Korea and increase engagement with academic network

Argument Relevance – proper answers (hypothesis) to the research question Logic – convincing causal explanations	25%

Policy Suggestion Realistic, feasible suggestions and recommendations based on the analysis of the causal mechanism	15%
Sources and References Proper use of APA 7 th edition Appropriate use of references, including in-text citations, and bibliography	5%
