Spanning over three years from 2023 to 2025, the Roundtable aims to create a necessary platform and opportunity for scholars and future generation leaders of various disciplines and ranks to identify core issues and propose creative solutions to democratic malaise, including but not limited to deepening inequality, polarization, and populism.

Student participants will have the unique opportunity to freely share their perspectives on the opportunities and threats to liberal democracy and network with like-minded participants.

4. FAQs

Is there an interview process during the application process?

Yes. In-person interviews will be held. We will contact applicable candidates individually to set up the interview.

Is English proficiency required?

Yes. The official language of the Roundtable is English. Therefore, in order to fully maximize your participation, English fluency is necessary. If English is your mother tongue, you do not have to submit English proficiency test scores.

What are preparatory sessions?



Preparatory sessions are pre-training activities through which you can better understand the program as well as roles to play throughout the program, learn more about democracy, and build rapport with other participants. It takes place once in two weeks, but specific dates and time are subject to change depending on participants' availability.

What is expected of Student Participants?

- Full participation in all activities including preparatory sessions
- Active and meaningful participation during discussions.
- Completion of all assignments.

What are the costs for participation?

All expenses, including meals, accommodation, transportation (except for in-Seoul transportation) during the duration of the Roundtable, as well as administrative and financial support for the post-SDRT activity, will be covered by KFAS. Personal expenses outside of the official program are not covered.
