1. Application for Scholarship

Candidates who wish to receive GSFS should apply for admission at SNU. During online application, the candidate MUST apply for the scholarship at the same time.

The dates above are subject to change depending on the circumstances.

<Eligibility: A GSFS applicant must be BOTH>

- (a) a non-Korean applicant whose parents do not hold Korean nationality
- (b) an applicant who has completed his/her entire education (equivalent to the period from the first year of elementary school to the final year of an university/graduate school he/she was attending just before applying to Seoul National University) outside of Korea
- (c) an applicant who holds the following academic degree or recognized equivalent from an accredited institution outside Korea:
 - 1) Applying for Master's / Combined Master's & Doctoral Programs: a bachelor's degree or higher
 - 2) Applying for Doctoral Programs: a master's degree or higher
- (d) an applicant who applied for the designated college/school(see below) participating in the GSFS Program for Fall 2024
- (e) an applicant who applied and is accepted into SNU for Fall 2024

<Selection Criteria>

Selection will be based on student's overall academic progress, records of past studies, study plan, personal statement, other achievement records and financial needs by each college.

Priority will be given to applicants who does NOT hold nationality of the designated countries. (see below)

2. Scholarship Benefits

<Tuition fee Support>

Recipients of this scholarship will receive full waiver of their tuition fee (except the application fee of KRW 90,000, which must be paid during online admission application) up to 2 academic years (4 semesters).

The recipient must maintain an average grade point of 3.0/4.3 and above in order to sustain the scholarship (Assessment will be done at the end of each semester)

<Living Support>

Monthly Stipends:

- -at least KRW 500,000/1 year (Master program applicants)
- -at least KRW 500,000/2 years (Doctorate program applicants)
- * Please note that the amount of living expenses and the duration of the stipend may vary depending on the individual college/school.

Contact details about the scholarship staff at each college/school will be available after you get an acceptance letter from SNU.

<Other Assistance provided>

The OIA will provide GSFS students with the following additional assistance:

- (a) Issuance of Certificate of Admission and Certificate of GSFS Scholarship
- (b) Registration Management

<Restrictions>

On principle, scholarship recipients are restricted from taking leave of absence. In the case you must take leave of absence due to special reasons, please contact the SNU OIA and your affiliated college/school in advance.
